Within the school we will be engaging in a variety of activities to enhance the pupils' knowledge about science and carry out plenty of 'hands on' enquiries.

We have also planned some exciting science workshops by some external educational providers, Oaks and Saplings will take part in a full day's workshop building their own 'vibrating brush monster' they will learn how to construct a simple series electric circuit and will compare how things move on different surfaces. Acorns will be visited by a menagerie of animals and the whole school will take part in a Lego Robotic workshop provided by PrepareRobo.
