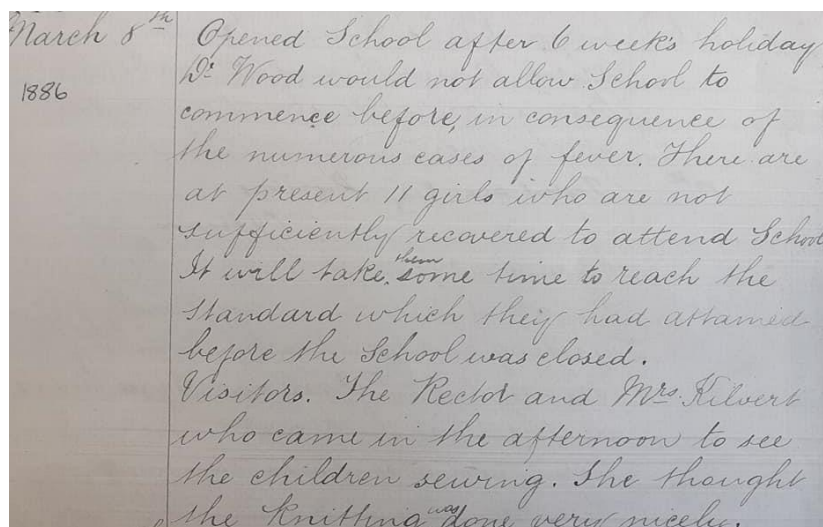


# Wootton School logbooks transcription project
