### REMOTE LEARNING

#### Resources

As we continue to forge ahead with remote learning I would like to take the opportunity to remind you that the resources that were uploaded to the school website in lock down 1 are all still available in the secure area of the website within Information for Parents. These include subject related resources as well as help and advice with regard to mental health and special educational needs.

The Coronavirus Information page has been updated. There is a new statement of information for parents with regard to remote education, which we have published as required by the DfE.

#### Physical work and marking

Please be mindful of the fact that, when work is handed in to the school in hard copy then it must be quarantined for three days. We have asked for work to be handed in on Mondays so that teachers are able to prepare resources for collection, by you, at the same time. As teachers are in school on a rota system to minimise contact there will be an unavoidable delay in giving feedback to physical work. For example; Mrs Palmer works two days one week and one day the next. This means that, if work is handed in on Monday, she will not be able to mark it until Monday or Wednesday of the following week. Clearly, this is not ideal but the school does have a duty to protect the staff as well as the children.

#### Technology issues

We understand that families may have technology issues with accessing live lessons, meets and online work. Should you have any problems in this regard then please contact Mrs Withey as she will be able to help.
